

Talk on Care at the End of Life. What do we know about death and dying? Has it been medicalized? This 4-hour workshop will give participants an understanding of the nursing, psychosocial, spiritual needs of patients at the end of life.

Course Objectives

This course aims to help participants to:

- Recognize and manage common symptoms of patients in their last hours
- Gain a basic understanding of psychosocial and spiritual needs of terminally ill patients
- Understand the needs and challenges of communication at the end-of-life

Training Methodology

Didactic lectures, pre-workshop readings, case sharing, quizzes, group discussions

- Physiologic changes of dying
- Common symptoms and their management in the final hours
- Psychosocial and spiritual needs at the end-of-life
- The role of advance care planning at the end-of-life
- Communication at the end-of-life
- Care for the deceased person
- Staff support
